



UWL Faith Service: Interfaith Awareness Calendar 2024-2025

This calendar identifies major religious festivals from communities represented at UWL. It highlights important dates that are expected to impact staff and students, such as holidays that require fasting or prohibit work. By developing this calendar, we aim to encourage UWL's community to be mindful and inclusive with timetabling and scheduling. This calendar is *not* an exhaustive list of religious festivals but rather focuses on those most likely to impact learning, teaching and work.

Please note: If we've missed a significant date or if any inaccuracies exist, please notify the Interfaith Adviser (faith@uwl.ac.uk). Be aware that within communities there can be a wide range of interpretation and adherence; this calendar aims to show what is commonly observed in consultation with faith groups.

High Impact: This festival significantly affects both staff and students who observe it. Whenever possible, the timetabling of deadlines, exams and important university work should be avoided on these dates. If avoiding these dates is not feasible, reasonable considerations should be provided for those impacted. Line managers should recognise that staff may request flexible working hours or annual leave.

Moderate Impact: If it is necessary to schedule deadlines, exams or important university work on these dates, alternative arrangements may be needed for some individuals. Additionally, some staff may request annual leave.

*Important: Muslim and Jewish festivals begin in the evening of the day prior to the date shown in this calendar. Asterisks have been included to indicate this.
